Chilean **Elite** firm Guerrero Olivos has strengthened its public law and regulated markets team by hiring a law professor as senior counsel.

Rosa Fernanda Gómez, 35, joined the firm on 1 June.

Gómez was previously a professor of administrative law at the Universidad de los Andes in Santiago for four months. Prior to that, she lectured at both Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile and Pontificia Universidad Católica de Valparaíso.

At Guerrero Olivos, she will advise local and international clients from regulated sectors. The department specialises in public law and constitutional litigation matters related to the energy, sanitary, telecoms and environmental industries. The practice is led by partners Eduardo Cordero and José Gabriel Undurraga.

Cordero says the firm strengthened its public law group as a response to “constant growth” in demand from clients. He adds that Gómez’s incorporation will allow the firm to develop its public litigation practice.

Guerrero Olivos is noted for its transactional offering and boasts strong energy, environment and mining practices. Back in April, the firm **helped** Mexican retailer FEMSA sell 16 convenience stores to Chilean fuel distributor Enx. A month prior, it **advised** Australian asset manager Macquarie in its US\$143 million acquisition of three office buildings in Santiago from global investment bank Credit Suisse.

The firm recently **added** two lawyers to its senior ranks, bolstering its corporate, finance and natural resources groups. Guerrero Olivos has 19 partners and one senior counsel.
